- GPA of at least 2.75 on 44-hours of coursework (including the 36-hour MSU General Education Requirements) and overall GPA of at least 2.5
- Grades of at least C in English Comp. I & II; College Algebra or a higher math; and all history, geography, political science, economics, psychology, and sociology coursework
- Two letters of recommendation
- Verification of 40 hours work experience with children/youth
- Criminal background check (<https://mycb.castlebranch.com> and enter code MI43)
- Purchase a 4 year subscription to Taskstream
- ACT Composite of 21 or higher **OR** SAT composite of 990 or higher **OR** Praxis Core scores of at least Reading-156, Writing-162, and Math-150
- Proof of professional liability insurance
- Signed MSU College of Education Dispositions form
