- Verification of 40 hours work experience with children/youth

- Purchase a 4 year subscription to Taskstream
- ACT Composite of 21 or higher **OR** SAT composite of 990 or higher **OR** Praxis Core scores of at least Reading=156, Writing=162, and Math=150
