REQUIREMENTS THAT MUST BE MET PRIOR TO APPLYING FOR ADMISSION TO MSU'S TEACHER EDUCATION PROGRAM (PHASE II):

- GPA of at least 2.75 on 44-hours of coursework (including the MSU General Education Requirements) and overall GPA of at least 2.5
Grades of at least C in all coursework
Two recommendation forms
Verification of 40 hours work experience with children/youth
Criminal background check from approved source
Purchase a 7 year subscription to Taskstream and proof of liability insurance
ACT Composite of 21 or higher OR SAT composite of 990 or higher OR Praxis Core scores of at least Reading=156, Writing=162, and Math=130 OR 3.0 GPA or higher on 60 hours of transfer work

May transfer up to 61 hours from the community college.
