- GPA of at least 2.75 on 44-hours of coursework (including the MSU General Education Requirements) and overall GPA of at least 2.5
Grades of at least C in all coursework
Two letters of recommendation
Verification of 40 hours work experience with children/youth
Criminal background check (https://mycb.castlebranch.com/ and enter code MI43)
Purchase a 4 year subscription to Taskstream
ACT Composite of 21 or higher OR SAT composite of 990 or higher OR Praxis Core scores of at least Reading=156, Writing=162, and Math=150
