REQUIREMENTS THAT MUST BE MET PRIOR TO APPLYING FOR ADMISSION TO MSU’S TEACHER EDUCATION PROGRAM (PHASE II):

- GPA of at least 2.75 on 44-hours of coursework (including the 36-hour MSU General Education Requirements) and overall GPA of at least 2.5
• Grades of at least C in all English coursework and College Algebra or a higher math
• Two letters of recommendation
• Verification of 40 hours work experience with children/youth
• Criminal background check (https://mycb.castlebranch.com/ and enter code MI43)
• Purchase a 4 year subscription to Taskstream
• ACT Composite of 21 or higher OR SAT composite of 990 or higher OR Praxis Core scores of at least Reading-156, Writing-162, and Math-150
• Proof of professional liability insurance
• Signed MSU College of Education Dispositions form
