- GPA of at least 2.75 on 44-hours of coursework (including the 36-hour MSU General Education Requirements) and overall GPA of at least 2.5
Grades of at least C in English Comp. I & II; College Algebra or a higher math; and all history, geography, political science, economics, psychology, and sociology coursework
Two letters of recommendation
Verification of 40 hours work experience with children/youth
Criminal background check (https://mycb.castlebranch.com and enter code MI43)
Purchase a 4 year subscription to Taskstream
ACT Composite of 21 or higher OR SAT composite of 990 or higher OR Praxis Core scores of at least Reading-156, Writing-162, and Math-150
Proof of professional liability insurance
Signed MSU College of Education Dispositions form
